Crushing or Splitting of Tablets

This document is in response to your request for information regarding the crushing or splitting of Tybost[®] (cobicistat [COBI]) tablets.

Product Labeling¹

There is no information in the COBI product labeling about the crushing or splitting of COBI, and COBI has a solubility of 0.1 mg/mL in water at 20°C. Therefore, it is not recommended that COBI be administered as a crushed or split tablet. The decision to administer COBI in a manner inconsistent with the product labeling is not recommended by Gilead Sciences and is at the discretion of the healthcare professional.

Gilead Data on the Crushing or Splitting of COBI Tablets

Crushing COBI tablets and adding into a liquid medium has not been studied and is not recommended. Currently, there are no studies evaluating the pharmacokinetics (eg, oral bioavailability) of a crushed COBI tablet dispersed into a liquid medium (eg, milk, water, juice) compared with a whole tablet.

Non-Gilead Data on the Crushing or Splitting of COBI Tablets

A literature search was conducted in Ovid MEDLINE and Embase databases for studies published between 1946 and January 12, 2026, using the search terms Tybost, cobicistat, and cutting, crushing, splitting tablets and related search terms. No relevant citations were identified.
